CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Trina Bouseman, L.P.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Bouseman's license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Trina Bouseman, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-080875 to practice practical nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 3, 2009. Said license is set to expire on August 31, 2015. Ms. Bouseman's primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. During the course of her employment with Our Lady of the Valley, Roanoke, Virginia on or about November 7, 2013, Ms. Bouseman presented a false document, via fax, to her employer regarding a prescription for Levaquin. On or about November 3, 2013, Ms. Bouseman had been observed by a fellow employee to have a blister pack of medication in her purse. The tablets did not have any markings and the packaging was not labeled. When questioned about the tablets Ms. Bouseman indicated that the tablets were Levaquin and that she had gotten the tablets from a friend who is a nurse. Our Lady of the Valley received a letter which indicated that Ms. Bouseman had received the medication from Moses Cone Health System, Greensboro, North Carolina. The letter was not on letterhead and Our Lady of the Valley was unable to confirm the authenticity of the letter or its author.
3. Ms. Bouseman was terminated from Our Lady of the Valley on November 18, 2013.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §54.1-3007(2) and (5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”) and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(e) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

CONSENT

Trina Bouseman, L.P.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Trina Bouseman, L.P.N. is hereby REPRIMANDED.

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
2. Ms. Bouseman shall provide the Board with verification that she has completed the following NCSBN course within 30 days of the entry of this Order: *Ethics in Nursing Practice*.

3. Ms. Bouseman shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

4. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order or of any law or regulation affecting the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall constitute grounds for the suspension or revocation of the license of Ms. Bouseman and an administrative proceeding shall be convened to determine whether such license shall be suspended or revoked.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

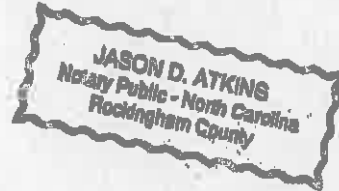
