Dear Ms. Noe:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered July 24, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Jamie H. Hoyle, Esquire, Chief Deputy Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Erica Nicole Noe, R.N., was convicted of a felony charge in the Circuit Court of Fairfax County, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Embezzlement. A certified copy of the Sentencing Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Erica Nicole Noe, R.N., to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Erica Nicole Noe, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Noe seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

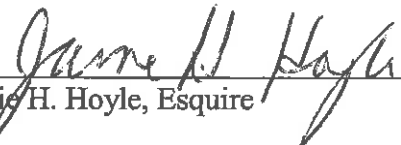

This case came before the Court for sentencing of the Defendant, who appeared in person with her Attorney, Edward J. Nuttall. The Commonwealth was represented by Gregory Holt. The Defendant appeared while on bond.

On April 28, 2014, the Defendant was found guilty of the following offense(s):

The pre-sentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code § 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guideline worksheets.



The sentencing guideline worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the Defendant desired to make a statement and if the Defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCED** the Defendant to:

INCARCERATION. Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: One (1) year.

SUSPENDED SENTENCE. The Court further **ORDERED** that all of the sentence be suspended, upon the following conditions(s):

UNSUPERVISED PROBATION. The Defendant is placed on inactive probation for two (2) years, or unless sooner released by the Court or by the Probation Officer. The Defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer.

COSTS. The Defendant shall pay all costs of this case.

CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED. The Defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to § 53.1-187 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended.

The Defendant was instructed to have DNA processing and then was released upon aforesaid conditions.
