NOTICE OF HEARING

("Code"), Kristie Charles, L.P.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on July 15, 2014,

held License No. 0002-077041 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal

administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be

held on January 28, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of

Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms.

Charles will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Charles has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Charles desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Kristie Charles, L.P.N., may have violated

certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Consent Order of the Board entered on July

15, 2014, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Charles may have violated certain laws governing practical

nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Kristie Charles, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 5 of the Consent Order entered on July 15, 2014, which required Ms. Charles to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") in that on or about August 20, 2014, Ms. Charles was dismissed from the HPMP due to noncompliance. Specifically, Ms. Charles failed to obtain a multidisciplinary assessment at the Farley Center as recommended.
