CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Lorie J. Woolridge, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Woolridge's application for registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By application received October 16, 2013, Lorie J. Woolridge applied for registration by examination as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
2. On March 11, 2010, Ms. Woolridge was convicted in the General District Court of Augusta County, Virginia, of one count of knowingly giving a false report as to the commission of a crime to a law enforcement officer with the intent to mislead, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was ordered to pay \$100.00 in fines and \$81.00 in costs.
3. Ms. Woolridge provided evidence showing that all costs were paid by June 3, 2010.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that:

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Ms. Woolridge otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3042 of the Code.

CONSENT

Lorie J. Woolridge, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document.
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for registration to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Lorie J. Woolridge for registration as a medication aide by examination is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the Virginia Medication Aide examination, the Board shall issue Ms. Woolridge an unrestricted registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
2. Lorie J. Woolridge is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Ms. Woolridge shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a medication aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
