NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Dana D. Coggsdale, L.P.N., who holds License No. 0002-056138 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, which is set to expire on November 30, 2014, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on May 22, 2014, at 9:30 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Coggsdale will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Coggsdale has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Coggsdale desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.


The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Dana D. Coggsdale, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing practical nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

1. Dana D. Coggsdale, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(5) and (6) of the Code in that on or about September 17, 2013, during the course of her employment with Emporia Manor, Emporia, Virginia, she submitted to a random urine drug screen which was positive for opiates, benzodiazepines, and cocaine.
2. Ms. Coggsdale may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that she may be unable to safely practice nursing due to mental illness and substance abuse which requires medication and treatment, and for which she was hospitalized on June 1, 2012.
