CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing, and Rebecca G. Haney, L.P.N., R.N., with her consent as evidenced by her signature below, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Haney's license to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Rebecca G. Haney, L.P.N., holds License No. 0002-055577 issued by the Board of Nursing.
2. During the course of Ms. Haney's employment with Gambro Healthcare, Kilmarnock, Virginia, on or about May 10, 2000, by her own admission, Ms. Haney reported for duty and then left between approximately 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon without advising anyone that she was leaving.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that the above Findings of Fact constitute a violation of § 54.1-3007(2) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.

CONSENT

Rebecca G. Haney, L.P.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. Ms. Haney acknowledges that she has been specifically advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. Ms. Haney acknowledges that she is fully aware that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000 A, et seq., of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended;
3. Ms. Haney acknowledges that she has the following rights among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, to reasonable notice of said administrative proceeding, to

representation by counsel, and the right to present witnesses and evidence on her behalf;


4. Ms. Haney waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. Ms. Haney admits to the above Findings of Fact;
6. Ms. Haney consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her practice of professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Consent Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby Orders that Rebecca G. Haney, L.P.N., who holds License No. 0001-055577, be, and hereby is, REPRIMANDED. The Board expects Ms. Haney to maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of Title 54.1, Chapter 30, of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to § 2.2-4023 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
