NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Adrienne Cicio, R.N., who prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on October 10, 2014, held License No. 0001-165306 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on January 28, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Cicio will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Cicio has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Cicio desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Adrienne Cicio, R.N., may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in an Order of the Board entered on April 9, 2014, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Adrienne Cicio, R.N., may have violated Term No. 6 of the Board Order entered April 9, 2014, which required her to comply with all terms of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") in that, on or about August 28, 2014, Ms. Cicio was dismissed from the HPMP for non-compliance with the terms of her contract in that she submitted a letter of resignation from the program.
