ORDER

On November 16, 2004, a Special Conference Committee of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") considered the petition filed by Adrienne Cicio, R.N., for the termination of probation imposed on her license to practice professional nursing on the Commonwealth of Virginia. The Committee adopted the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Adrienne Cicio, R.N., holds License No. 0001-165306 issued by the Virginia Board of Nursing.
2. An Order was entered by the Virginia Board of Nursing in the matter of Ms. Cicio on September 23, 2003, placing her license on indefinite probation with terms and conditions
3. Upon review of the evidence, the Board concludes that Ms. Cicio has complied with the terms and conditions of her probation.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Adrienne Cicio, R.N., for termination of her probation be GRANTED, and that she be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
