# **ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law affecting the license of Cynthia McCaffrey, R.N., to practice as a professional nurse in Virginia.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Cynthia McCaffrey, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-107629 to practice as a professional nurse by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 17, 1987. Said license expired on November 30, 2013. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. By an Order of the Board entered on August 3, 2007, the Board reprimanded Ms. McCaffrey and placed her on indefinite probation with terms and conditions, for not less than four years of actual nursing practice. This action was due to findings that Ms. McCaffrey diverted a fentanyl patch and submitted a positive urine drug screen for several schedule II controlled substances during the course of her employment with Mary Immaculate Hospital, Newport News, Virginia.
  - 3. On May 1, 2011, Ms. McCaffrey submitted a petition for release from probation.
- 4. Ms. McCaffrey has completed over six years of Board-approved nursing employment at ECPI, Newport News, Virginia.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. This matter is properly before the Board.
- 2. Cynthia McCaffrey, R.N., has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation.

#### ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Cynthia McCaffrey, R.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and upon renewal and payment of any related fees Ms. McCaffrey shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing.

Ms. McCaffrey shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
