ORDER

Upon petition of Cynthia G. McCaffrey, R.N., for termination of her probation, a Special Conference was held on November 27, 1995, in Henrico County, Virginia, pursuant to § 54.1-110 and § 54.1 -3010 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("the Code"). Ms. McCaffrey was not present.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. An Order for reinstatement and probation was entered by the Virginia Board of Nursing in the matter of Cynthia G. McCaffrey, R.N., on December 22, 1992, placing Ms. McCaffrey's license to practice professional nursing on probation with terms and conditions.
- 2. Ms. McCaffrey has complied with the terms and conditions of her probation.
- 3. Ms. McCaffrey is able to engage in the unrestricted practice of professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the Findings of Fact, the Board concluded that Cynthia G McCaffrey, has met the requirements of § 54.1-3009.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby Ordered that the petition of Cynthia G. McCaffrey, for termination of probation be granted and that she be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
