Dear Ms. Pratt-Smith:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered April 11, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

ORDER

On THIS DAY, came the Attorney for the Commonwealth, Jeff Adams, and the Defendant, who stands charged with a felony, to-wit: Possession of Schedule I/II Controlled Substance, as charged in the Amended Indictment; and came also her attorney, Beverly Haney.

It appearing to the Court that the Defendant has failed to comply with the deferral period pursuant to Virginia Code § 18.2-251, this case came on this day for disposition, in accordance with the plea agreement executed on <u>September 28, 2011</u>.

The Court finds the Defendant guilty of Possession of I/II Controlled Substance, as charged in the Amended Indictment. It being demanded of the Defendant if anything he had or knew to say why judgment should not be pronounced against her according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment it is accordingly the judgment of this Court that the Defendant is hereby sentenced in accordance with the aforementioned plea

CR11-1143: Three (3) years with two (2) years and six (6) months suspended.

This sentence shall run consecutively to any other sentences imposed in any other proceeding or Jurisdiction unless expressly set forth above.

The suspension of the sentence is conditioned upon the following:

Good behavior. The Defendant shall be of good behavior for a period of three (3) years.

<u>Supervised Probation</u>. Upon her release from confinement, the Defendant is ordered placed on active supervised probation for a period deemed appropriate by the Office of Probation and Parole.

<u>Costs</u>. The Defendant shall pay costs in this proceeding within thirty (30) days, unless a payment plan is submitted and accepted by the Clerk.

<u>Credit for time served</u>. The Defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement on this charge.

The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the Defendant was personally present and her attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the Defendant.

And the Defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
