Roach, L.P.N., may have violated Term No. 1 of the Board Order entered September 27, 2011, which required her to comply with all terms of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") in that, on or about March 21, 2014, Ms. Roach was dismissed from the HPMP for noncompliance due to her failure to comply with the urine toxicology screening program and her failure to respond to telephone messages and/or written correspondence from HPMP.
