NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Megan R. Roach, L.P.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on March 4, 2010, held License No. 0002-073839 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 12, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Roach will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Roach has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Roach desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Roach may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board (“Board’s Order”) entered on March 4, 2010, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Megan R. Roach, L.P.N., may have violated Term 6 of the Board's Order entered March 4, 2010, which required Ms. Roach to comply with the terms and conditions imposed by the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that on or about April 29, 2011, Ms. Roach was dismissed from the HPMP for noncompliance with her monitoring contract.
