CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Antoinette House, C.N.A., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. House's certificate to practice as a

nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT** 

1. Antoinette House was issued Certificate No. 1401-021127 to practice as a nurse aide by the

Virginia Board of Nursing on February 16, 1991. Said certificate expired on February 28, 2014.

2. During her employment at Envoy of Stratford Hills, Richmond, Virginia, on October 19,

2013, Ms. House responded inappropriately to a resident after said resident had made derogatory remarks to

her.

3. On October 22, 2014, Ms. House's employment at Envoy of Stratford Hills was terminated.

She acknowledged that her reaction to the resident was due to being stressed over short staffing and she let

her emotions get in the way.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as

amended ("Code").

**CONSENT** 

Antoinette House, C.N.A., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. Ms. House has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document:

- 2. Ms. House acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. Ms. House acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
  - 4. Ms. House waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. Ms. House admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. Ms. House consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

## <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS that:

- 1. Antoinette House, C.N.A., is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Ms. House shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
