NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Anna Marie G. Morris, who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on February 3, 2011, held Certificate No. 1401-033834 to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on March 17, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Morris will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Morris has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Morris desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.


The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon Ms. Morris’ application for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, which was indefinitely suspended on February 3, 2011, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Morris may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nurse aide practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

The burden rests upon Ms. Morris, as the petitioner, to demonstrate that she is capable of resuming the safe and competent practice of a nurse aide in Virginia.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Anna Marie G. Morris, C.N.A., may have violated § 54.1-3007(1) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-25-100(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides in that on her applications for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide received on September 28, 2010, and September 10, 2013, Ms. Morris failed to disclose her conviction for driving under the influence on or about October 4, 2007, in the Danville, Virginia, General District Court, and a 2006 misdemeanor conviction for shoplifting.
