NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Min Soon Kim, C.M.T., who holds Certificate No. 0019-008585, which expires on January 31, 2015, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on March 19, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Kim will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Kim has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Kim desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

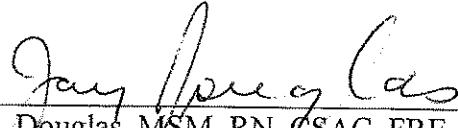
The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Kim may have violated certain laws and regulations governing certified massage therapy practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that on or between August 11-12, 2011, while Min Soon Kim, C.M.T., was the part owner and working at Top Therapy, Falls Church, Virginia, an inspection by county licensing inspectors and police revealed:

1. Ms. Kim may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5), and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-50-90(2)(d) and (i) of the Regulations Governing the Certification of Massage Therapists ("Regulations"), as referenced in § XIV of the Code of Ethics of the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork, in that she was observed engaging in sexual activity with a client.
2. Ms. Kim may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5), and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-50-90(2)(g) of the Regulations in that she employed massage therapists who were untrained and unlicensed.
