IN RE: KANESHIA MINGGIA, C.N.A. APPLICANT

CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Kaneshia Minggia, C.N.A., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Minggia's application for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Kineshai Minggia submitted an application for certification as a nurse aide by examination to the Board, which was received on November 22, 2013.
2. On September 13, 2012, Ms. Minggia was convicted in the Henrico County, Virginia, Circuit Court of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
3. On July 19, 2010, Ms. Minggia was convicted in the General District Court of the County of Henrico, Virginia, of receiving/buying stolen goods valued at less than \$200.00, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Findings of Fact Nos. 2 and 3 constitute violations of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Ms. Minggia otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

CONSENT

Kaneshia Minggia, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

2. She acknowledges that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

### **ORDER**

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Kaneshia Minggia for certification as a nurse aide by examination is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP examination, she shall be issued a certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth.
2. Ms. Minggia is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Ms. Minggia shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

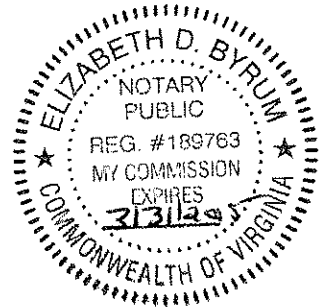
