Dear Ms. Dillard:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered March 28, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

[X] Special conditions:

Probation shall include substance abuse counseling, parenting classes, and reasonable efforts to maintain gainful employment. Defendant shall be subject to random drug screens while under probation supervision as follows: on a weekly basis during the first year of probation; twice per month during the second year of probation; on a monthly basis during the third year of probation; and at the discretion of the Probation Officer for the remainder of the time that the defendant is under probation supervision.

Defendant shall be considered for inpatient treatment for her substance abuse issues. Defendant shall provide the Probation Officer with a current list of all of her prescriptions and medical providers and shall execute any releases or other documents that may be necessary for the Probation Officer to access her medical information. Defendant shall not be taking or using the drug Suboxone after June 1, 2014 unless ordered by a physician, and a hearing shall be held if defendant has not ceased taking or using Suboxone by June 1, 2014.

[X] Additional Provisions

Defendant shall be of good behavior beginning immediately and continuing for twenty (20) years after defendant's completion of probation as specified above.

[] The defendant was remanded to the custody of the sheriff.

[X] The defendant was allowed to depart.

The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code § 53.1-187.
