NOTICE OF HEARING

Wollenberg will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Wollenberg has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Wollenberg desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Wollenberg may have violated certain

laws governing the practice of nursing and certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the

Order of the Board entered on January 30, 2013 ("Board's Order"), as more fully set forth in the Statement

of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Lori Wollenberg, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 5(a) of the Board's Order, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") for the period specified by the HPMP, in that on or about March 21, 2014, Ms. Wollenberg was dismissed from the HPMP due to continued psychiatric relapses.
