Pursuant to § 9-6.14:12, § 54.1-110 and § 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as

amended (the "Code"), a formal administrative hearing was held before a panel of the Board of

Nursing (the "Board") on September 9, 1998, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon

evidence that Lethia B. Gada, R.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the

practice of professional nursing in Virginia. The case was prosecuted by Stephen V. Baer,

Assistant Attorney General. Howard M. Casway, Assistant Attorney General, was present as legal

counsel for the Board. Ms. Gada was present and was not represented by an attorney. The

proceedings were recorded by a certified court reporter.

Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Board found that there existed no clear

and convincing evidence to support findings of violations of the Nurse Practice Act and/or the

Rules and Regulations of the Board of Nursing.

**ORDER** 

WHEREFORE, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby

ORDERS that the matter of Leitha B. Gada, R.N., be, and hereby is, DISMISSED.

shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
