ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

Pursuant to §§ 54.1-110 and 54.1-2408.1(A) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a

quorum of the Board of Nursing ("Board") met by telephone conference call on February 12, 2014, after a good

faith effort to convene a regular meeting of the Board had failed. The purpose of the meeting was to receive

and act upon certain information indicating that Amy Wetherholt, R.N., may have violated certain laws and

regulations relating to the practice of professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia, as more fully set

forth in the attached "NOTICE OF HEARING and STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS," which is attached

hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

WHEREUPON, pursuant to its authority under § 54.1-2408.1(A) of the Code, the Board concludes that a

substantial danger to public health or safety warrants this action and ORDERS that the license of Amy

Wetherholt, R.N., License No. 0001-202239 to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia

is hereby SUSPENDED. It is further ORDERED that a hearing be convened forthwith to receive and act upon

evidence in this case and that the Executive Director of the Board shall be authorized to execute this Order and

all other documents, notices and orders on behalf of the Board necessary to bring this matter to a hearing.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Amy Wetherholt, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and no

longer current.

This Order shall be applicable to Ms. Wetherholt's multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice

professional nursing.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended

("Code"), Amy Wetherholt, R.N., who, prior to its summary suspension by the Board of Nursing on

February 18, 2014, held License No. 0001-202239 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, which was set

to expire on July 31, 2015, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the

presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on March 19, 2014 at 2:00 p.m., at the

offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive.

Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Wetherholt will be afforded the opportunity to be

heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Wetherholt has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Wetherholt desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Amy Wetherholt, R.N., may have violated

certain laws and regulations governing professional nursing practice in Virginia, and to inquire into evidence

that Ms. Wetherholt may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order

of the Board entered December 6, 2012 ("Board's Order"), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

- 1. Amy Wetherholt, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (3), (5) and (6) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) and (e) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that on several occasions between June 15, 2013, and September 6, 2013, Ms. Wetherholt either obtained or attempted to obtain fraudulent prescriptions for various Schedule II and Schedule III medications, including amphetamine salts (Schedule II), morphine sulfate (Schedule II), oxycodone hydrochloride (Schedule II), and hydrocodone/APAP (Schedule III) at various pharmacies. She accomplished the diversion by using a prescription pad and signature stamp that she stole from an employer.
- 2. Ms. Wetherholt may have violated Term 1(a) of the Board's Order, which required that she have an evaluation by an addictionologist and a neurologist, approved by the Board, within 90 days of entry of the Order. The evaluations were due to the Board on March 6, 2013. On March 1, 2013, Ms. Wetherholt requested and was granted an extension until April 30, 2013, to obtain the evaluations. Ms. Wetherholt has failed to obtain the required evaluations.
