**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Jennifer Bucklew, C.N.A., who holds Certificate No. 1401-143804 to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, which expires on April 30, 2014, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on January 27, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Bucklew will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Bucklew has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Bucklew desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.


The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Jennifer Bucklew, C.N.A., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nurse aide practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

**STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS**

The Board alleges that Jennifer Bucklew, C.N.A., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2) and (5) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-25-100(2)(j) of the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides in that from

approximately June/July 2012 to March 2013, during the course of her employment with Mary Immaculate Hospital, Newport News, Virginia, by her own admission, Ms. Bucklew regularly accessed the records of patients not assigned to her.
