CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("The Board") and Kay Brown Suzanne Archevald, R. N., as evidenced by their signatures affixed below, agree to enter into this Consent Order affecting the license of Ms. Archevald to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board adopts the following findings of fact in this matter:

1. Kay Brown Suzanne Archevald, R.N., was issued license number 0001-096110 by the Board to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on March 18, 1985. Said license is active and will expire on May 31, 2012, unless renewed or otherwise restricted.
2. By Summary Suspension Order entered September 12, 2008, the Virginia Board of Nursing summarily suspended Ms. Archevald's license to practice nursing.
3. By Consent Order entered October 31, 2008, the Board continued indefinitely the suspension of Ms. Archevald's license. This action was based on Ms. Archevald's violation of § 54.1-3007(2), (3), (5) and (6) of the Code and 18VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) of the Board of Nursing Regulations in that between December 17, 2007 and July 17, 2008, during the course of her employment with Chesapeake Regional Medical Center, Chesapeake, Virginia, she diverted Demerol IM injectables (meperidine, Schedule II) from patient supplies for her personal and unauthorized use.
4. By Order entered November 2, 2009, the Board reinstated Ms. Archevald's license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Further, she was placed on certain terms and

conditions to include complying with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") for the period specified by the HPMP.

3. By Default and Decision Order effective on February 7, 2011, the State of California Board of Registered Nursing revoked the Registered Nurse License issued to Kay Suzanne Archevald, R.N. This action was based solely on the Virginia Board's Order of Summary Suspension entered September 12, 2008 and subsequent Consent Order entered October 31, 2008.

4. By Order entered April 18, 2011, the Director of the Department of Health Professions mandatorily suspended Ms. Archevald's license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code due to the action of the California Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter of the reinstatement of Ms. Archevald's license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is properly before the Board.

CONSENT

I, Kay Brown Suzanne Archevald, R.N., by affixing my signature hereto, acknowledge that:

1. I have been advised specifically to seek the advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me, except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000.A et seq. of the Code of Virginia;
3. I have the following rights, among others:
 - a. the right to a formal hearing before the Board; and
 - b. the right to appear in person or by counsel, or other qualified representative before the agency.

4. I waive all rights to an informal conference;
5. I admit the truth of the above Findings of Fact; and
6. I consent to the following Order affecting my license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and with the consent of the licensee, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Kay Brown Suzanne Archevald, R.N., to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia, be, and hereby is, REINSTATED effective April 18, 2011, pursuant to the terms and conditions placed on her as referenced in the Board's Order of November 2, 2009.

Ms. Archevald shall maintain a course of conduct in her practice of nursing commensurate with the requirements of Title 54.1, Chapter 29 of the Code and all laws of the Commonwealth.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

19 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

20 1. On or about May 28, 2009, Complainant Louise R. Bailey, M.Ed., RN, in her official
21 capacity as the Interim Executive Officer of the Board of Registered Nursing, Department of
22 Consumer Affairs, filed Accusation No. 2009-306 against Kay Suzanne Archevald (Respondent)
23 before the Board of Registered Nursing. (Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)

24 2. On or about July 25, 2008, the Board of Registered Nursing (Board) issued
25 Registered Nurse License No. 732670 to Respondent. The Registered Nurse License was in full
26 force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on June 30,
27 2010, unless renewed.

28 3. On or about June 4, 2009, Respondent was served by Certified and First Class Mail
copies of the Accusation No. 2009-306, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for
Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at

8 4. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of
9 Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business & Professions Code section
10 124.

11 5. On or about June 12, 2009, Respondent signed and returned a Notice of Defense,
12 requesting a hearing in this matter. A Notice of Hearing was served by mail at Respondent's
13 address of record and it informed her that an administrative hearing in this matter was scheduled
14 for July 6, 2010. Respondent failed to appear at that hearing.

15 6. Government Code section 11506 states, in pertinent part:

16 (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent
17 files a notice of defense, and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts
18 of the accusation not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense shall
19 constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion
20 may nevertheless grant a hearing.

21 7. California Government Code section 11520 states, in pertinent part:

22 (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense or to appear at the
23 hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions
24 or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to
25 respondent.

26 8. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Board finds
27 Respondent is in default. The Board will take action without further hearing and, based on the
28 evidence obtained under its investigatory authority and by the taking official notice of all the
investigatory reports, exhibits and statements contained therein on file at the Board's offices
pertaining to the prosecution of Accusation No. 2009-306, the Board finds that the charges and
allegations in Accusation No. 2009-306, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct
by clear and convincing evidence.

1 indefinitely. A copy of the Virginia Board's Consent Order is attached as Exhibit B to the
2 Accusation, and is incorporated herein.

3 **ORDER**

4 **IT IS SO ORDERED** that Registered Nurse License No. 732670, heretofore issued to
5 Respondent Kay Suzanne Archevald, is revoked.

6 Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a
7 written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within
8 seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may
9 vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

10 This Decision shall become effective on February 7, 2011.

18 **PARTIES**

19 1. Complainant brings this Accusation solely in her official capacity as the
20 Executive Officer of the Board of Registered Nursing ("Board"), Department of Consumer
21 Affairs.

22 **License History**

23 2. On or about July 25, 2008, the Board issued Registered Nurse License
24 Number 732670 ("license") to Kay Suzanne Archevald, also known as Kay B. Archevald
25 ("Respondent"). The license will expire on June 30, 2010, unless renewed.

26 **STATUTORY PROVISIONS**

27 3. Section 2750 of the Business and Professions ("Code") provides, in
28 pertinent part, that the Board may discipline any licensee, including a licensee holding a

1 temporary or an inactive license, for any reason provided in Article 3 (commencing with Code
2 section 2750) of the Nursing Practice Act.

3 4. Code section 2764, in pertinent part, that the expiration of a license shall
4 not deprive the Board of jurisdiction to proceed with a disciplinary proceeding against the
5 licensee or to render a decision imposing discipline on the license.

6 5. Code section 118, subdivision (b), provides that the suspension,
7 expiration, surrender, or cancellation of a license shall not deprive the Board of jurisdiction to
8 proceed with a disciplinary action during the period within which the license may be renewed,
9 restored, reissued or reinstated.

10 6. Code section 2761 states, in pertinent part:

11 The board may take disciplinary action against a certified or
12 licensed nurse or deny an application for a certificate or license for any of
the following:

13 (a) Unprofessional conduct, which includes, but is not limited
14 to, the following:

15 (4) Denial of licensure, revocation, suspension, restriction, or
16 any other disciplinary action against a health care professional license or
17 certificate by another state or territory of the United States, by any other
government agency, or by another California health care professional
licensing board. A certified copy of the decision or judgment shall be
conclusive evidence of that action.

18 COST RECOVERY

19 7. Code section 125.3 provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request
20 the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or
21 violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation
22 and enforcement of the case.

23 CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

24 (Out-of-State Discipline)

25 8. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 2761,
26 subdivision (a)(4), on the grounds of unprofessional conduct, in that Respondent was disciplined
27 by the State of Virginia Board of Nursing ("Virginia Board"), in the case entitled, *In re: Kay B.*
28 *Archevald*, as follows:

1 a. Effective September 12, 2008, pursuant to the Virginia Board's Order of
2 Summary Suspension, the Virginia Board suspended Respondent's Registered Nurse License
3 No. 001-096110. The action was based upon allegations in that between December 17, 2007,
4 and July 17, 2008, during the course of her employment with Chesapeake Regional Medical
5 Center, Respondent diverted Demerol, a Schedule II controlled substance, from hospital supplies
6 for her own personal use, and was thereby deemed to be a substantial danger to the public health
7 and or safety. A copy of the Virginia Board's Order of Summary Suspension is attached as
8 Exhibit A, and is incorporated herein.

9 b. Effective October 31, 2008, pursuant to the Virginia Board's Consent
10 Order, the Virginia Board suspended Respondent's Registered Nurse License No. 001-096110
11 indefinitely. A copy of the Virginia Board's Consent Order is attached as Exhibit B, and is
12 incorporated herein.

13 **PRAYER**

14 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein
15 alleged, and that following the hearing, the Board of Registered Nursing issue a decision:

16 1. Revoking or suspending Registered Nurse License Number 732670 issued
17 to Kay Suzanne Archevald, also known as Kay B. Archevald;

18 2. Ordering Kay Suzanne Archevald, also known as Kay B. Archevald to pay
19 the Board the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to
20 Code section 125.3; and

21 3. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.





Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Kay B. Archevald, R.N., who, prior to its summary suspension by the Board of Nursing on September 9, 2008, held License No. 0001-096110, which was set to expire on May 31, 2010, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Archevald may have violated certain laws and regulations governing professional nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

The Board alleges that Ms. Archevald may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (3), (5) and (6) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) of the Board of Nursing Regulations in that, by her own admission, between December 17, 2007 and July 17, 2008, during the course of her employment with Chesapeake Regional Medical Center, Chesapeake, Virginia, she diverted Demerol (meperidine, Schedule II) IM injectables from patient supplies, for her own personal and unauthorized use.

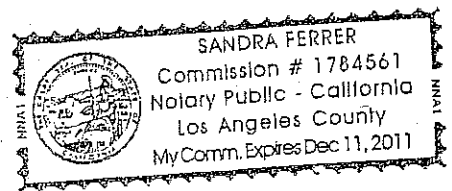
