CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Angela Gilbert, L.P.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Gilbert's license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Angela Gilbert, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-083392 to practice practical nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on September 21, 2010. Said license expired on May 31, 2015. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. By Consent Order of the Board entered on February 12, 2014, the Board took no action against Ms. Gilbert contingent upon her remaining in compliance with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), for the period specified by the HPMP. Said action was based on findings that Ms. Gilbert called in prescriptions for Tussionex (hydrocodone/chlorpheniramine, C-II) for herself and multiple family members using the name of her supervising physician. She also diverted Xanax (alprazolam, C-IV), and oxycodone (C-II) for her personal and unauthorized use.
- 3. Ms. Gilbert entered a Participation Contract with the HPMP on April 30, 2013. She signed her fifth Recovery Monitoring Contract on March 10, 2015.

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- 4. Ms. Gilbert's license expired on May 31, 2015, and the HPMP gave her until June 30, 2015, to renew it. Ms. Gilbert reported that she had no plans to renew her license. Ms. Gilbert also reported that she has not worked as a nurse since 2013 and has no immediate plans to return to nursing practice.
- 5. On July 17, 2015, Ms. Gilbert was dismissed from the HPMP due to her ineligibility to participate without a current active license.
- 6. At the time of her dismissal, Ms. Gilbert was in compliance with her Recovery Monitoring Contract.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 5 constitutes a violation of Term No. 3 of the Consent Order entered February 12, 2014.

CONSENT

Angela Gilbert, L.P.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;

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6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Angela Gilbert, L.P.N., is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. The Board ACCEPTS the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER for INDEFINITE SUSPENSION of Ms. Gilbert's license to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
 - The license will be recorded as suspended and no longer current.
- 4. At such time as Ms. Gilbert shall petition the Board for reinstatement of her license, an administrative proceeding will be convened to determine whether she is capable of resuming the safe and competent practice of practical nursing. Ms. Gilbert shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of the license prior to issuance of the license to resume practice.
 - 5. This suspension applies to any multistate privilege to practice practical nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
