Dear Ms. Robinson:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certificate to practice as a certified massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered September 4, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your certificate, contact Jay Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4599.

resume practice.

The defendant was led before the bar of this Court, for sentencing and appeared in person with appointed counsel, Po Chau, public defender. The Commonwealth of Virginia was represented by Christine Cestaro and Janae Craddock.

The defendant moved to set aside the verdict. Having heard argument, the motion was denied. The Court proceeded on sentencing. On May 1, 2014, the defendant was found guilty of the following offense indicated below.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 7 years.

The sentences shall run consecutively with all other sentences.

The Court SUSPENDS 2 years of the sentence, for a period of 7 years, upon the following condition(s):

Good Behavior. The defendant shall keep the peace and be of good behavior upon the defendant's release from confinement.

DNA Testing. The defendant shall submit to DNA testing pursuant to §19.2-310.2 of the Virginia Code (1950), as amended, if not already done.

Supervised Probation. The defendant is placed on probation, to commence on release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer until released by the Court or by the Probation Officer. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. Probation shall include substance abuse counseling and/or testing to be monitored or approved by the Probation Officer. The defendant shall report within 48 hours upon release from confinement.

Substance Abuse Assessment. The defendant shall undergo a substance abuse assessment pursuant to §18.2-251.01 and enter a treatment and/or education program as directed by the Department of Corrections. The defendant shall pay all or part of the costs of the program, including the costs of the screening, assessment, testing, and treatment, based upon his ability to pay.

Costs. The defendant shall pay the costs of court, including court appointed attorney fees, if applicable, and any interest that may accrue until the balance is paid in full.

The Commonwealth moved for restitution in the amount of \$660.00 to CICF, which motion was granted.

Credit was given for time served.

The defendant's attorney shall advise the defendant of appeal rights. The Public Defender's Office is appointed to represent the defendant on appeal. If appealed the transcripts shall be made a part of the record.

Departure. The defendant is remanded to jail pending transfer to the Virginia Department of Corrections.
