## NOTICE OF INFORMAL CONFERENCE

Dear Ms. Williams:

This is official notification that an informal conference will be held pursuant to §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021, and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), on December 12, 2013, at 9:00 a.m., at the Department of Health Professions, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233. You may be represented by an attorney at the conference. This informal conference will be convened as a public meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3700 et seq. of the Code.

The Special Conference Committee ("Committee"), which is comprised of at least two members of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board"), will receive and act upon your application for the reinstatement of your registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia, and will inquire into allegations that you may have violated certain laws and regulations governing medication aide practice in Virginia, and that grounds may exist to deny your application for reinstatement.

## Specifically:

- 1. You may have violated §§ 54.1-3007(2), (3), (5) and (8) and 54.1-3041 of the Code in that from on or about January 1, 2012, through June 27, 2013, you practiced as a medication aide without having a valid registration to do so.
- 2. You may not meet the requirements of 18 VAC 90-60-100(C)(2)(b) and (c) of the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides in that you failed to provide evidence of that you have retaken and passed the written and practical competency evaluation, and that you have completed four hours of continuing education for the year of 2012.

The burden of providing evidence satisfactory to the Board that you are prepared to resume the competent practice as a medication aide with reasonable skill and safety to patients rests with you.

After the informal conference, the Committee is authorized by § 54.1-2400(10) of the Code to take any of the following actions:

- The Committee may reinstate your registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth without restriction:
- The Committee may reinstate your registration and place you on probation for such time as it may designate and subject to such terms and conditions as it may deem appropriate, reprimand you, or impose a monetary penalty; or
  - The Committee may deny your application for reinstatement of your registration.

Further, the Committee may refer the case to the Board of Nursing or a panel thereof for a formal hearing.

If you fail to appear at the informal conference, the Committee may proceed to hear the case in your absence and may take any of the actions outlined above. At least ten days prior to the scheduled date of the conference, please inform this office at (804) 367-4515, or in writing at the address listed above, of your telephone number and whether you intend to appear at the informal conference.

To facilitate this proceeding, you should submit five copies of any documents you wish the Committee to consider to the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive. Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, by December 5, 2013. Your documents may not be submitted by facsimile or email.

You have the right to the information on which the Board will rely in making its decision. Therefore, I have enclosed a copy of the documents that will be distributed to the members of the Committee and will be considered by the Committee when discussing any allegations with you and when deliberating on your case. These documents are enclosed only with the original notice sent by certified mail, which you may be required to claim at the post office. Please bring these documents with you to the informal conference.

Relevant sections of the Administrative Process Act, which govern proceedings of this nature, as well as laws relating to the practice of nursing and other healing arts in Virginia cited in this notice, can be found on the Internet at http://leg1.state.va.us. To access this information, please click on the Code of Virginia for statutes and Virginia Administrative Code for regulations.

In the event of inclement weather, please be advised that Board of Nursing hearings will be held unless state offices are closed. Please listen to television or radio announcements to provide information about official state closings or delays. If there is a delayed opening, hearings will begin at the time of the agency opening.
