Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certification to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered January 13, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board of Nursing present at the hearing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your certificate, contact Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4639.

This day came the attorney for the Commonwealth, Jamie Staples, and Simone Cesilie Jacobs, (hereinafter referred to as defendant), who stands indicted for a felony, to-wit: Grand Larceny, (Virginia Code Section 18.2-95), who appeared according to the conditions of her recognizance, and also came Joshua Goff, defendant's attorney. Vicky DeBerry, court appointed court reporter, was sworn to faithfully and accurately take down and transcribe the proceedings herein.

Whereupon the defendant was arraigned, and after private consultation with and being advised by counsel, pleaded GUILTY to the Indictment, which plea was tendered by the defendant in person, and the Court having made inquiry and being of the opinion that the defendant fully understood the nature and effect of the plea and of the penalties that may be imposed upon conviction, and after having been first advised by counsel and by the Court of the right to trial by jury, the defendant knowingly and voluntarily waived trial by jury and with the concurrence of the attorney for the Commonwealth and of the Court, here entered of record, the Court proceeded to hear and determine this case without the intervention of a jury, as provided by law.

The defendant, by counsel, having stipulated to the evidence of the Commonwealth, and the defendant offering no evidence herein, the Court finds the defendant GUILTY as charged in said



indictment, to-wit: Grand Larceny, (Virginia Code Section 18.2-95), a felony.

The Court, on its own motion, before fixing punishment or imposing sentence, directs the Probation Officer of this Court to thoroughly investigate the history of the defendant and report all relevant facts to the Court, in an expedited report, as provided by law, and sentencing is set for March 3, 2013, at 10:00 AM, before Judge H. Vincent Conway, Jr., to which time this case is continued.

Supervised Probation. The defendant is placed on probation pending sentencing, under the supervision of a Probation Officer. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. Probation shall include substance abuse counseling and/or testing as prescribed by the Probation Officer. Furthermore, the defendant shall undergo a substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment as directed by the Department of Corrections and shall pay all fees associated with substance abuse treatment or intervention as required by such program(s) on an ability to pay basis.

The record made by the Court Reporter herein of the said proceedings is filed as part of the record in this case. The Court certifies that at all times during the trial of this case the defendant was personally present and the defendant's attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the defendant.

The defendant is released on present bond.
