#### **CONSENT ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Cierra Carter, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Carter's application for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. By application received September 23, 2013, Cierra Carter applied for certification by examination as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 2. On June 2, 2009, in the Roanoke City, Virginia, General District Court, Ms. Carter was convicted of petit larceny.
- 3. Ms. Carter paid the court costs associated with the above conviction. Ms. Carter submitted a letter of support from Berkshire Health & Rehabilitation, Vinton, Virginia, which is her current employer and where she received her nurse aide training.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
  - 2. Ms. Carter otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

## **CONSENT**

Cierra Carter, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
  - She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

### <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Cierra Carter for certification by examination as a nurse aide is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP examination, Ms. Carter shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth.
  - Ms. Carter is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Carter shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides.
