CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and David Patterson, R.N., as evidenced by his signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Patterson's license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. David Patterson, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-233391 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 30, 2011. Said license is set to expire on February 28, 2014. His primary state of residence is Virginia.

2. During the course of his employment with Mary Washington Hospital, Fredericksburg, Virginia, Mr. Patterson diverted narcotic pain medications from hospital supplies for his personal and unauthorized use. Mr. Patterson's employment was terminated in March 2013 as a result of his drug diversion.

- 3. Mr. Patterson has a history of addiction to narcotic pain medication, which arose from his being prescribed narcotics to treat pain associated with various medical conditions.
- 4. Mr. Patterson entered into a Participation Contract with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") on May 6, 2013. He was placed on warning status after acknowledging that he abused hydrocodone and cocaine while participating in the HPMP.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2), (5), and (6) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.
  - 2. Findings of Fact Nos. 3 and 4 constitute a violation of § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code.

## **CONSENT**

David Patterson, R.N., by affixing his signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. He has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. He acknowledges that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against him except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. He acknowledges that he has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against him;
  - 4. He waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. He admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives his right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. He consents to the entry of the following Order affecting his right to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

## <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The Board shall TAKE NO ACTION at this time contingent on Mr. Patterson's continued compliance with the HPMP for the period specified by the HPMP.
- 2. This Order is applicable to Mr. Patterson's multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice professional nursing. For the duration of this Order, Mr. Patterson shall not work outside of the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to a multistate licensure privilege without the written permission of the Virginia Board of Nursing and the Board of Nursing in the party state where he wishes to work. Any requests for out of state employment should be directed, in writing, to the Executive Director of the Board.
- 3. Mr. Patterson shall maintain a course of conduct in his capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
- 4. Any violation of the terms and conditions stated in this Order shall be reason for revoking the license of Mr. Patterson, and an administrative proceeding shall be held to decide whether his license should be revoked. Mr. Patterson shall be noticed to appear before the Board at such time as the Board is notified that:
- a. He is not in compliance with the terms and conditions of the HPMP, or has been terminated from participation in the HPMP;
- b. There is a pending investigation or unresolved allegation against him involving a violation of law or regulation or any term or condition of this Order; or
- c. He has successfully completed the above-referenced period of participation in the HPMP. However, upon receipt of evidence of Mr. Patterson's participation in and compliance with the HPMP, the Board, at its discretion, may waive his appearance before the Board and conduct an administrative review of this matter.
