CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Bryan Williams, L.P.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Williams' license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Bryan Williams, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-080989 to practice practical nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 18, 2009. Said license expired on March 31, 2013. On April 24, 2013, Mr. Williams renewed his license and it is now set to expire on March 31, 2015. Mr. Williams' primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. Between April 2, 2013 and April 16, 2013, during the course of his employment with Pheasant Ridge Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Roanoke, Virginia, Mr. Williams practiced as a practical nurse without a valid license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §§ 54.1-3007(3), 54.1-3008(A)(2) and (4) and 54.1-3011(C) of the Code of Virginia (1950) as amended, ("Code").

CONSENT

Bryan Williams, L.P.N., by affixing his signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. He has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

2. He acknowledges that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against him except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. He acknowledges that he has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against him;
4. He waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. He admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives his right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. He consents to the entry of the following Order affecting his right to practice practical nursing in Virginia.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Bryan Williams, L.P.N., shall pay a MONETARY PENALTY of \$100.00 to the Board within 30 days of the entry of this Order.
2. Mr. Williams shall maintain a course of conduct in his capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
3. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order or of any law or regulation affecting the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall constitute grounds for the suspension or revocation of the license of Mr. Williams and an administrative proceeding shall be convened to determine whether such license shall be suspended or revoked.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
