Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certificate to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered December 12, 2013. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate suspended, shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

2. One (1) Count of Grand Larceny.


A Certified copy of the Court Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

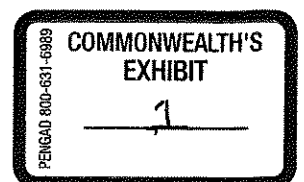
ORDER -CASE NOS. CR13-2682, 2683-00F

On October 24, 2013, came Michael Huberman, the attorney for the Commonwealth and Althea Moran, born December 6, 1960, who stands indicted for two (2) felonies, to-wit: larceny with intent to sell, having a value of \$200.00 or more (Virginia Code Section 18.2-108.01) in Case No. CR13-2682-00F, and grand larceny (Virginia Code Section 18.2-95) in Case No. CR13-2683-00F, as charged in the indictments, appeared according to the conditions of her bond and Dennis M. Martin, her attorney heretofore appointed, was also present this day.

Whereupon the accused was arraigned and after private consultation with and being advised by her counsel, pleaded guilty to the indictments, which pleas were tendered by the accused in person. And the Court, having made inquiry and being of the opinion that the accused fully understood the nature and effect of her pleas and of the penalties that may be imposed upon conviction and of the waiver of trial by jury and of appeal, finding that the pleas were voluntarily and intelligently entered, proceeded to hear and determine these cases without the intervention of a jury as provided by law.

Having heard all the evidence and argument of counsel, the Court finds the defendant guilty of larceny with intent to sell, having a value of \$200.00 or more (Virginia Code Section 18.2-108.01) in Case No. CR13-2682-00F, and grand larceny (Virginia Code Section 18.2-95) in Case No. CR13-2683-00F, as charged in the indictments.

The Court, on motion of the defendant by counsel, before fixing punishment or imposing sentence, directs the Probation Officer of this Court to thoroughly investigate, to include alternative sentencing evaluation and victim impact, if the Commonwealth is



so inclined, and report to the Court as provided by law on the 9th day of January, 2014, and sentencing is set for the 14th day of January, 2014, at 1:30 o'clock p.m., to which time these cases are continued.


The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the defendant was present in person and her attorney was likewise present in person and capably represented the defendant.


