Dear Mr. Watson:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certificate to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered July 24, 1998.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of thirty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board of Nursing.





Anthony Dwayne Watson, Jr., defendant,

Anthony Dwayne Watson, Jr., who stands indicted for  
a felony, to-wit: feloniously and unlawfully break and enter in the  
daytime the dwelling house of Lowrey Lewis, situate at number 833  
Circlewood Drive, with intent to commit a larceny therein;

this day appeared in keeping with his recognizance, and also  
appeared Christopher Anderson, his Attorney at law, and Michael  
Herring, an Assistant Attorney for the Commonwealth.

Thereupon, the defendant being arraigned, after  
consultation with counsel, pleaded guilty to said charge and the  
Court, after inquiry, found for a fact that the defendant's plea of  
guilty was made freely, voluntarily and intelligently and was  
accordingly accepted.

Whereupon, the evidence in this case having been  
stipulated by the defendant and the Commonwealth and upon the  
defendant's plea of guilty, and a plea agreement submitted to the  
Court and approved, the Court doth find the defendant guilty as  
charged in the Indictment, and after allocution of the defendant,  
and in accordance with said plea agreement, it is the judgment of  
this Court and Ordered by the Court that the defendant be committed  
to the Department of Corrections for five (5) years, said sentence  
is suspended for ten (10) years, conditioned upon the defendant's  
good behavior; he is placed on supervised probation; and that he



make restitution in the sum of \$250.00 to the victim, Lowrey Lewis.

It is further Ordered pursuant to title 19.2, Article 1.1, etc. of the Code of Virginia 1950 as amended, the defendant is to report to the Sheriff of the City of Richmond to have a sample of his blood withdrawn for the purpose set forth in the aforesaid sections.

It is further Ordered that the Commonwealth do recover of the defendant her costs incident to this proceeding, and that the defendant pay the Court costs at the rate of \$50.00 per month commencing July 15, 1996, and each month thereafter until paid in full.
