Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certification to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered September 26, 2012. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board of Nursing present at the hearing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your certificate, contact Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4639.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Dianne L. Reynolds-Cane, M.D., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Bernard Talla Kamgang, C.N.A., was convicted of a felony charge in the Circuit Court for the County of Chesterfield, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Hit & Run. The defendant came before the Court for sentencing and appeared in person with counsel, Keith Hurley. The Commonwealth was represented by Kenneth M. Chitty.

Karim Halty, a French interpreter, was present and sworn by the Court to assist the defendant during this court hearing.

On March 15, 2012 the defendant was found guilty of the following offense(s):

The pre-sentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in accordance with the provisions of Code § 19.2-299. The victim impact statement was received and ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

The Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets, pursuant to the provisions of \$19.2-298.01. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 10 years.

The Court SUSPENDS the 10-year sentence, upon the following condition(s):

Incarceration with the Chesterfield County Jail for the term of: 11 months and 20 days.

Good Behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior upon the defendant's release from confinement, for a period of 10 years.

DNA testing. The defendant shall submit to DNA testing pursuant to §19.2-310.2 of the Virginia Code (1950), as amended.

Costs. The defendant shall pay court costs, including attorney fees, if court appointed, and any interest that may accrue until the balance is paid in full.

Interest is deferred on all fines and/or costs pending the defendant's release from incarceration on this/these charge(s). No deferral is extended to those defendants participating in alternative programs.

Restitution. The defendant shall make restitution in accordance with the Restitution Order entered on June 19, 2012.

Stay of Execution/Departure: The Court stays execution of the sentence until June 27, 2012 at 8:00 a.m. and allows the defendant to depart on the condition the defendant reports to the jail of this county at that time to begin serving the active sentence imposed, and may serve the sentence on educational release or participate in the sheriff's work release program, if qualifies.
