NOTICE OF HEARING

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Gabriele Hart, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5), and (6) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that during the course of her employment with American Treatment Center, Newport News, Virginia, in or about February 2013, by her own admission, she diverted at least four 90mg bottles of liquid methadone (Schedule II) from facility supplies for her personal and unauthorized use.
