NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Kelli L. Saxton, R.N., who holds License No. 0001-213096 which expires on July 31, 2015, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. 23233, at which time Ms. Saxton will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Saxton has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Saxton desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Saxton may have violated certain laws governing professional nursing practice in Virginia and certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on December 4, 2013 ("Order"), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Ms. Saxton may have violated Term No. 1 of the Board's Order, which took no action against Ms. Saxton's license contingent on her compliance with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") and § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code, in that HPMP dismissed Ms. Saxton from the program for non-compliance on May 16, 2014. Prior to her dismissal, Ms. Saxton failed to attend HPMP orientation, failed to sign a Recovery Monitoring Contract, failed to participate in treatment, and failed to comply with the urine toxicology screening.
