NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Jingnan Zhang, who, prior to its mandatory suspension by the Department of Health Professions on November 22, 2013, held Certificate No. 0019-009494 to practice as a massage therapist in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 15, 2014, at 9:30 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Zhang will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Zhang has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Zhang desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon the application of Jingnan Zhang for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a massage therapist in Virginia, which was mandatorily suspended by the Department of Health Professions on November 22, 2013, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Zhang may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of massage therapy in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

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The burden rests upon Ms. Zhang, as the applicant, to demonstrate that she is capable of resuming the safe and competent practice of massage therapy in Virginia.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2409 of the Code, reinstatement of Ms. Zhang's certificate requires the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board in attendance at the hearing.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

- 1. Jingnan Zhang may have violated § 54.1-3007(7) of the Code in that by Final Order entered October 31, 2013, by the State of Florida Board of Massage Therapy, Ms. Zhang's license to practice massage therapy was revoked. Said action formed the basis of the mandatory suspension of her certificate to practice in Virginia.
- 2. Ms. Zhang may have violated § 54.1-3007(1) and (3) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-50-90(1) and (2)(h) and (i) of the Regulations Governing the Certification of Massage Therapists, incorporating by reference the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork Code of Ethics, Parts II and XVIII, in that on the application for licensure submitted to the Florida Board of Massage Therapy, Ms. Zhang falsely indicated that she completed the Florida College of National Health (FCNH) Therapeutic Massage Training Program on January 1, 2011. Further, she submitted a fraudulent transcript and certificates of completion.
