ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues the following Order regarding the license of Bethany L. Cejer, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Bethany Cejer, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-203791 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on September 18, 2006. Said license is set to expire on May 31, 2014. Ms. Cejer also holds active licenses to practice professional nursing in the states of California, Delaware, New York, Ohio, and Pennsylvania and expired professional nursing licenses in the states of Washington and West Virginia. Her primary state of residence is Ohio.
2. On June 28, 2010, the Pennsylvania Board of Nursing placed Ms. Cejer on probation for three years with certain terms and conditions. This action was based on Ms. Cejer's 2005 and 2008 convictions for driving under the influence and an evaluation that indicated that she suffers from alcohol dependence disorder and depressive disorder.
3. By Order of the Board entered on February 11, 2013, Ms. Cejer was placed on indefinite probation until such time that she was released from probation by the Pennsylvania Board of Nursing.
4. On July 26, 2013, Ms. Cejer submitted a petition for release from probation and provided a copy of the Order from the Pennsylvania Board of Nursing entered July 10, 2013, reinstating her license to an unrestricted status.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This matter is properly before the Board.
2. The Board concludes that Bethany L. Cejer, R.N., has satisfied the terms of her probation.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Bethany L. Cejer, R.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Cejer shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing.

Ms. Cejer shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.


