NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Jamel Q. Smith, R.M.A., who holds Registration No. 0031-005244 to practice as a medication aide in Virginia, which is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2013, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 16, 2013, at 2:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Mr. Smith will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Mr. Smith has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on his behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Mr. Smith desires any witnesses to appear on his behalf, he must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.


The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Mr. Smith may have violated certain laws and regulations governing medication aide practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Jamel Q. Smith, R.M.A., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-60-120(2)(f) of the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides in

that during the course of his employment with The Heritage Inn Assisted Living, Charlottesville, Virginia, on or about September 18, 2012, while providing care to Residents A and B, Mr. Smith handled the residents in a rough manner and cursed at them.
