substantial danger to public health or safety warrants this action and ORDERS that the Certificate of Martin M.

Martin, C.N.A., Certificate No. 1401-013512, to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is

hereby SUSPENDED. It is further ORDERED that a hearing be convened forthwith to receive and act upon

evidence in this case and that the Executive Director of the Board shall be authorized to execute this Order and

all other documents, notices and orders on behalf of the Board necessary to bring this matter to a hearing.

Upon entry of this Order, the certificate of Martin M. Martin, C.N.A., will be recorded as suspended

and no longer current.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
