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Aides in that during the course of her employment with Morningside of Bellgrade Assisted Living Facility, Midlothian, Virginia, on or about October 5, 2012, while attempting to give medication to an agitated Resident A, Ms. Thomas pinched the resident's nose and held her mouth open.
