CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Gregory W. Taylor, as evidenced by his signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Taylor's application for registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By application received September 1, 2011, Gregory W. Taylor applied for registration by examination as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
2. On August 24, 2011, during the course of his employment at Lynmoore Richmond West End Assisted Living Facility, Richmond, Virginia, a Department of Social Services licensing inspector observed Mr. Taylor passing out medication to residents when he was not licensed to do so.
3. Mr. Taylor stated that he was ordered to pass the medications by his supervisor.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Mr. Taylor otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3042 of the Code.

CONSENT

Gregory W. Taylor, by affixing his signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. He has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

2. He acknowledges that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against him except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. He acknowledges that he has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against him;
4. He waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. He admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives his right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. He consents to the entry of the following Order affecting his application for registration to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

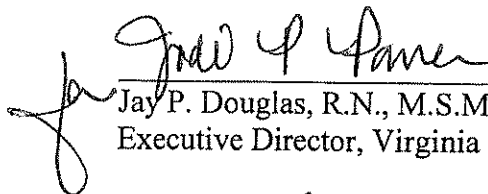
ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

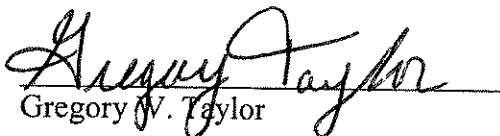
1. The application of Gregory W. Taylor for registration as a medication aide by examination is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the Virginia Medication Aide examination, the Board shall issue Mr. Taylor an unrestricted registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
2. The Board shall TAKE NO ACTION at this time against Mr. Taylor.
3. Mr. Taylor shall maintain a course of conduct in his capacity as a medication aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

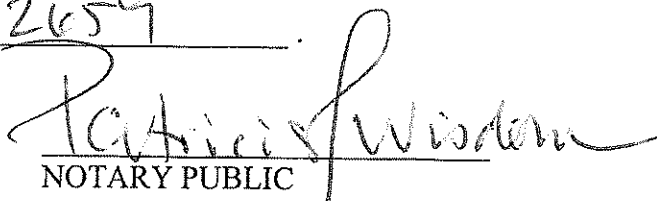
