


STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Committee of the Joint Boards alleges that Jean Black, L.N.P., may have violated §§ 54.1-2957.01(E)(2) of the Code (effective until July 1, 2012) and 54.1-3007(2), (3), (5) and (8) of the Code, 18 VAC 90-30-220(2), (3) and (4) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners, and 18 VAC 90-40-100(B)(1) and (2) of the Regulations for Prescriptive Authority for Nurse Practitioners in that during the course of her employment with Mountain Springs Family Practice, Copper Hill, Virginia, from February, 2008, to January, 2012, she regularly prescribed Schedule II through Schedule VI drugs, including numerous narcotics, to patients while practicing independently of a supervising physician. The primary supervising physician and secondary supervising physician listed on Ms. Black's Prescriptive Authority Practice Agreements practiced at a location separate from where she practiced, never visited her practice location, and never reviewed a random sample of her patient records.
