ORDER

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 54.1-110 and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a formal administrative hearing was held before a panel of the Board of Nursing ("Board") on September 16, 2015, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon Ms. Bennett's application for reinstatement of her license to practice practical nursing in Virginia which was mandatorily suspended by an Order of the Department of Health Professions entered on September 9, 2013, and to inquire into evidence that Cathy Bennett, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nursing practice in Virginia. The case was presented by Wendy Deaner, Adjudication Specialist, Administrative Proceedings Division. James Rutkowski, Assistant Attorney General, was present as legal counsel for the Board. Ms. Bennett was present and was not represented by legal counsel. The proceedings were recorded by a certified court reporter.

Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Board adopted the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Cathy Bennett, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-051194 to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on June 1, 1995. Said license was mandatorily suspended by an Order of the Department of Health Professions entered September 9, 2013. Ms. Bennett's primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. On August 13, 2013, Ms. Bennett pled guilty to and was convicted of one count of felony conspiracy to solicit murder in the Franklin County, Virginia, Circuit Court. At her sentencing on October

17, 2013, Ms. Bennett was sentenced to a period of five years incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections, with three years and six months suspended. She was placed on supervised probation for a period of four years with eight years of good behavior.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §54.1-3007(4) of the Code.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- The application of Cathy Bennett for reinstatement of License No. 0002-051194 to practice 1. practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby DENIED, due to a failure to obtain the affirmative vote for reinstatement of three-fourths of the members of the Board at the hearing. Further, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Ms. Bennett be CONTINUED on INDEFINITE SUSPENSION. At such time as she shall petition the Board for reinstatement of her license, an administrative proceeding will be convened to determine whether she is able to return to the safe and competent practice of practical nursing.
 - 2. The license shall be recorded as suspended.
- This Order shall be applicable to Ms. Bennett's multistate licensure privileges, if any, to 3. practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
