**ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues the following Order regarding the license of Diana Minnix, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Diana Minnix, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-183492 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on January 28, 2003. Said license is set to expire on August 31, 2014. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. By Order entered November 25, 2008, Ms. Minnix was reprimanded and placed on indefinite probation for not less than three years of nursing practice due to findings that she had inappropriate relationships with inmates at Nottoway Correctional Center and that she entered a plea agreement whereby charges of attempted carnal knowledge of an inmate would be ordered *nolle prosequi* should she satisfactorily complete her court ordered probation. By Order entered November 30, 2011, Ms. Minnix was reprimanded and continued on indefinite probation for not less than three years of nursing practice due to findings that she failed to comply with the terms and conditions of probation to include failing to notify the Board in a timely manner of her employment at Community Memorial Healthcenter.
3. By letter received on February 6, 2013, Ms. Minnix submitted a petition for release from probation.
4. Ms. Minnix has substantially complied with the terms of the Order entered November 30, 2011.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. This matter is properly before the Board.
2. Ms. Minnix has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation.


**ORDER**

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Diana Minnix, L.P.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Minnix shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing.

Ms. Minnix shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.


