ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of

Law and issues the following Order regarding the license of Hollie D. Riner, R.N., to practice professional

nursing in Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Hollie D. Riner, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-226544 to practice professional nursing

by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 5, 2010. Said license is set to expire on June 30, 2015. Ms.

Riner also holds License No. 61420 to practice professional nursing in the state of West Virginia, which is

set to expire on October 31, 2013. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.

2. On November 10, 2009, the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional

Nurses ("West Virginia Board") entered an Order reinstating Ms. Riner's license to practice as a registered

professional nurse for one year, re-suspending the license for one year and staying the suspension contingent

upon compliance with terms of the West Virginia Board's Order and placing her on probation with terms for

three years.

3. On July 26, 2010, the Virginia Board of Nursing entered an Order approving Ms. Riner's

application for licensure by endorsement and placing her on probation with terms and conditions to run

concurrently with the period of probation set forth in the West Virginia Board's Order.

4. By letter received on October 10, 2012, Ms. Riner submitted a petition for release from

probation.

By letter dated March 25, 2013, the West Virginia Board reported that Ms. Riner successfully 5. completed the probation requirements.

Ms. Riner has complied with the terms of the Virginia Board Order entered July 26, 2010. 4.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This matter is properly before the Board.

Ms. Riner has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation. 2.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Hollie D. Riner, R.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Riner shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing.

Ms. Riner shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
