# CONSENT ORDER

The Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine ("Committee of the Joint Boards") and Elizabeth Smith, R.N., L.N.P., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Smith's license to practice as nurse practitioner in Virginia.

The Committee of the Joint Boards adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

# FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Elizabeth Smith, R.N., L.N.P., was issued License No. 0024-063072 to practice as a nurse practitioner by the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine on January 29, 1986. Ms. Smith also holds License No. 0001-063072 issued by the Virginia Board of Nursing to practice professional nursing in Virginia on September 1, 1976. Both licenses are current and set to expire on January 31, 2010.
- 2. During the course of her employment with Anesthesia Management Services, Mount Airy, Maryland, Ms. Smith diverted fentanyl (Duragesic, Schedule II) and Demerol (meperidine, Schedule II), for her own personal and unauthorized use, approximately 20 times in 2007, and approximately 10 times in 2008. Further, Ms. Smith adulterated the vials of medications to make them appear full in order to avoid detection.
- 3. On August 18, 2008 and October 7, 2008, Ms. Smith entered Recovery Monitoring Contracts with the Health Practitioners' Intervention Program ("HPIP"). Ms. Smith is currently in compliance with her HPIP Recovery Monitoring Contract.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (6) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-30-220(5) and (6) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners.

#### CONSENT

Elizabeth Smith, R.N., L.N.P., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Committee of the Joint Boards, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
  - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact in any subsequent proceeding before the Committee of the Joint Boards;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice as a nurse practitioner in Virginia.

### <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The Committee of the Joint Boards shall TAKE NO ACTION against the nurse practitioner license of Elizabeth Smith, L.N.P., at this time contingent on her compliance with all terms and conditions of her Recovery Monitoring Contract with the HPIP for the period specified in the Contract.
  - 2. Any violation of the terms and conditions stated in this Order shall be reason for revoking the

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License of Elizabeth Smith, L.N.P., and an administrative proceeding shall be held to decide whether her

ricense should be revoked. Ms. Smith shall be noticed to appear before the Committee of the Joint Boards at

such time as the Committee of the Joint Boards is notified that:

a. Ms. Smith is not in compliance with the terms and conditions of the HPIP, or has been

terminated from participation in the HPIP;

b. There is a pending investigation or unresolved allegation against Ms. Smith involving

a violation of law or regulation or any term or condition of this Order; or

c. Ms. Smith has successfully completed the above-referenced period of participation in

the HPIP. However, upon receipt of Ms. Smith's participation in and compliance with the HPIP, the

Committee of the Joint Boards, at its discretion, may waive Ms. Smith's appearance before the Committee of

the Joint Boards and conduct an administrative review of this matter.

3. Ms. Smith shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse practitioner

commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the

Licensure of Nurse Practitioners.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in

the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public

inspection or copying upon request.
