ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues this Order affecting the license of Jacqueline D. Trask, R.N., to practice professional nursing

in Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Jacqueline D. Trask, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-246853 to practice professional 1.

nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 8, 2013. Said license is valid in Virginia only and is

scheduled to expire on February 28, 2017. Ms. Trask also holds License No. 567408 to practice professional

nursing in the State of New York, which expired on January 31, 2014. Ms. Trask declared New York as her

primary state of residence.

By Order of the Board entered on August 8, 2013, the Board approved Ms. Trask's 2.

application for licensure and placed her on probation for 24 months of active employment as a professional

nurse, with terms and conditions. Said action was due to findings of fact that Ms. Trask was convicted of the

unauthorized use of a computer in Elmira City Court, Chemung County, New York. Subsequently, Ms.

Trask's professional nursing license was suspended by the New York State Board of Nursing, with the

suspension stayed, and she was placed on probation for two years with terms and conditions.

Ms. Trask submitted a petition for release from probation on November 16, 2014. 3.

Ms. Trask has complied with all terms and conditions of probation. 4.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- This matter is properly before the Board.
- 2. Jacqueline D. Trask, R.N., has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation.

<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Jacqueline D. Trask, R.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Trask shall be issued a license to practice as a professional nurse, that is valid in Virginia only.

Ms. Trask shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
