IN RE: AMY E. JENKINS, C.N.A. APPLICANT

CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Amy E. Jenkins, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Jenkins' application for certification to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Amy E. Jenkins submitted an application for certification by examination as a medication aide, which was received by the Board on May 1, 2013.
2. On August 10, 2011, in the General District Court of Winchester, Virginia, Ms. Jenkins was convicted of misdemeanor shoplifting. She was sentenced to 30 days' incarceration, with all 30 days suspended conditioned on her being of good behavior for one year, and ordered to pay a fine and costs.
3. Ms. Jenkins submitted evidence that she has satisfied the terms of her conviction order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Ms. Jenkins otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

CONSENT

Amy E. Jenkins, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Amy E. Jenkins for certification by examination as a nurse aide is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP examination, Ms. Jenkins shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.
2. Ms. Jenkins is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Ms. Jenkins shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a certified nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
