NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Julia A. McKinnis, R.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on May 8, 2014, held License No. 0001-136083 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on July 16, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. McKinnis will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. McKinnis has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. McKinnis desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Julia A. McKinnis, R.N., may have violated certain laws governing professional nursing practice in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. McKinnis may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on March 26, 2013 (“Board’s Order”), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.


STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

1. Julia A. McKinnis, R.N., may have violated Term No. 5 of the Board's Order in that on or about April 25, 2014, Ms. McKinnis was dismissed from the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") due to noncompliance. Specifically, Ms. McKinnis returned to practice at Angel Wings Home Care, without HPMP approval.

2. Ms. McKinnis may have violated § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code in that on or about July 7, 2014, in the Circuit Court of Pittsylvania County, Virginia, Ms. McKinnis was convicted of misdemeanor obtaining drugs by fraud.
