Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certificate to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered January 10, 2013. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate suspended, shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I,

Arne W. Owens, Chief Deputy Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and

acted upon evidence that Kerry Alleen Lynch, C.N.A., was convicted of felony charges in the Circuit Court

for the City of Colonial Heights, Virginia, to wit:

1. One (1) Count of Credit Card Theft; and

Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her

certificate prior to issuance of her certificate to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall

remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

The defendant came before the Court for sentencing and appeared in person with counsel, **Stephen K. Armstrong**. The Commonwealth was represented by **A. Gray Collins, III**.

On October 23, 2012 the defendant was found guilty of the following offense(s):

All parties waive their right to a pre-sentence report.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record.


Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCES** the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 20 years for CR12-367-01.

The sentence shall run **consecutively** with all other sentences.

The Court SUSPENDS 20 years of the CR12-367-01 sentence, and suspends imposition of sentence on the CR12-367-02 charge, for a period of 20 years, upon the following condition(s):

Good Behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for 20 years upon the defendant's release from confinement and/or until all fines and costs are paid in full.

DNA Testing. The defendant shall submit to DNA testing pursuant to §19.2-310.2 of the Virginia Code (1950), as amended.

Supervised Probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence on release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for such period of time deemed necessary for the defendant's proper rehabilitation. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. Probation shall include random drug screening. The defendant shall submit to any search and seizure by any Probation and Parole Officer during any period of active probation.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs of \$1,970.00, and any interest that may accrue until the balance is paid in full.

Departure. The defendant is remanded to jail pending release on this charge.

Credit for Time Served. The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code § 53.1-187.
